



Sports Day 22nd June 2026- Parents are invited

It is our very first **Sports Day** since before Covid-19, on **Monday 22nd June 2026**.

We haven't had a sports day since 2019 as our last sports day events were very problematic. We have had many sports event, but parents haven't been invited due to previous safeguarding concerns. However, this year, we feel we can give it another go. Parents are all on board with our safeguarding rules and so I am sure we can run this event smoothly and safely.

Timings will be:

- F1am & F1pm, F2 and KS1. 9.30am- 11.30am
- KS2. 1.30pm-3pm
- If there is time at the end of each session there will be a parent's race, so bring your trainers too!

Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing, plimsolls or trainers suitable to run in and are protected from the sun with a hat, sun cream and a water bottle. In case of bad weather our Sports Day will be cancelled, and a message will be put on the school website.

We do have a few rules for you to follow please:

- We will only be opening the bottom gate, so please come to school via that entrance.
- We will set out chairs for parents to sit on, please use them and don't stand up or move the chairs to other locations.
- Remain seated behind the barriers, please do not cross the barrier yourself or encourage your child to come to you.
- In line with our Safeguarding Policy and Social Media Parental Agreement, there should be no phones out during the event- Miss Dibley will be taking photos which will be shared with you via Class Dojo.
- We ask that you don't swear and only have child appropriate conversation on site.
- Do not vape or smoke on school site.
- Show respect to others- any violent behaviour or aggressive language may lead to a school site ban.
- You will not be able to park on the school site, so if you do drive, please park considerately.
- There will be no toilet access for parents as the toilets will be for children's use only - we won't be able to let adults share their facilities.
- **At the end of the event**, children will be escorted back into their classroom, and the barrier will be removed. If it is the usual home time for your child, please collect him/her from their classroom. **Please do not collect your child(ren) early** from teachers on the field as this can cause confusion and may cause undue risk to the safety of the children in our care.
- In an emergency, please speak to a member of staff.

I am aware this all sounds rather strange and to some may seem unnecessary, but I can assure you we have had someone break each of the above rules in the past. We really want to hold these events in the future and so ask you to make sure everyone is following the rules.
