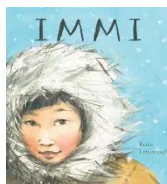


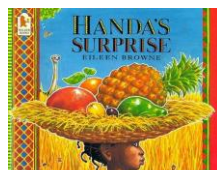
# F2 Overview for the Summer Term

We will start the term finding out about a cold place. Fred the Frog will be visiting The Arctic and we will read a story called Immi.



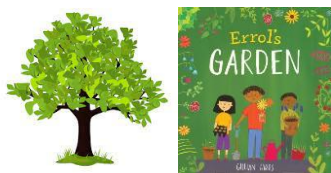
After half term we will read Handa's Surprise and find out what life is like in Kenya. We will compare this to the other parts of the world we have learned about.

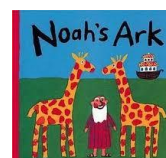


Before visiting the farm, we will learn about animals and their babies which are born during Spring.
