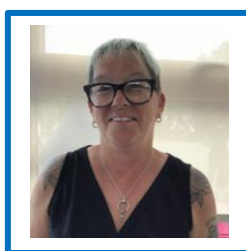

Mrs Broniewska works on **Monday, Tuesday** (in class) and **Wednesday and Thursday**.

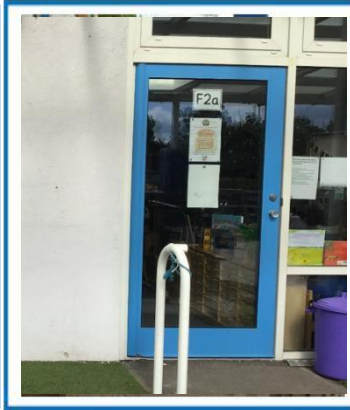
Mrs Humphrey works on **Wednesday, Thursday and Friday**.

This is the door to your classroom.



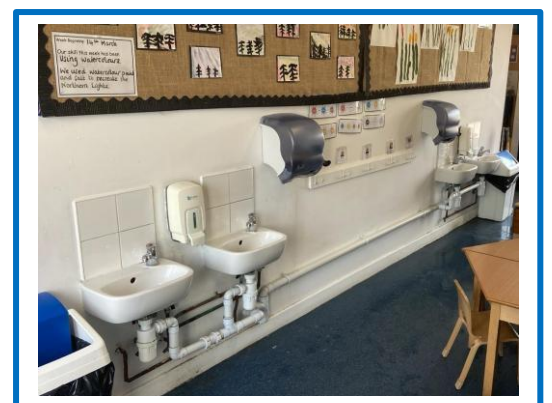
This is your carpet area

Other helpful hints

- Please bring a book bag containing reading folder every day. This should be a rectangular bag and not a backpack, which may bend the corners of our books.
- For morning snack, you can bring in a piece of fruit or raisins
- Your child will need to bring a labelled water bottle to school every day. This must only contain water and not juice or flavoured water.
- Please label **ALL** clothing and belongings.
- You will need a pair of wellies in school. Waterproof trousers are optional
- You will need spare uniform including pants and socks in your book bag.
- You will take home a picture book to share every week, we would like you to share books at home and record this in the reading diary. Dojo points will be awarded each time your child reads/shares a story.
- If your child would like milk this can be ordered online each term.
- Your child will receive a free piece of fruit for their afternoon snack.
- Your child will have a Class Dojo account when they join school. We will post important reminders and often photos of events in school. Please make sure you have these details and can access the account. Any problems please speak to us.
