We have lots planned, including:

- Take a break with some delicious cake and a cup of tea.
- Will you be lucky at the ever-popular 'Wine to Water' stall?

As at previous fairs this one will be cashless - **blue Fair Tokens** are available to pre-purchase via ParentPay and will also be on sale at the Fair on the day (purchase by debit or credit card). Tokens are 50p each.

We will be holding our traditional **Summer Raffle** with lots of lovely prizes up for grabs (donations of additional Raffle prizes would also be greatly appreciated). Raffle tickets are £1 and can be purchased via ParentPay in advance or at the Summer Fair.



The "big draw" will take place at the end of the Summer Fair (we will contact anyone that wins a prize but is unable to attend the Summer Fair).

Pre-purchase tokens and raffle tickets will be available for collection from the school office from after school on Monday 5th June (if you have any blue tokens from previous Fairs you may use them at the Summer Fair).



This year we will be selling **Lucky Boxes** - please can the children help us fill a small box with gifts worth £1 (it can be sweets, colouring pencils, a keyring etc. - see poster for more information).

NON-UNIFORM DAY - On **Friday 16th June** we are having a non-uniform day in preparation for the Summer. If your child would like to come to school in their ordinary clothes they will need to bring a chocolate or bottle donation for the Summer Fair.
