## This week:

• Some of our Year 5 children were lucky enough to be invited to compete in maths and physics activities at Nottingham High School, and two of our teams even managed to be placed in the top four schools. We have been learning about how to stay safe on the internet as part of our **Safer Internet Day**. The main message of the assembly was to be Sharp Alert Safe Secure Brave while using the internet. Road Safety - Another CCTV car could soon be patrolling the roads outside schools looking for drivers who are parking illegally. The County Council already operates two camera enforcement cars and will be stepping up their efforts to keep children safe at drop off and pick up times. Last year more than 600 drivers were caught out and handed Penalty Charge Notices.



The CCTV cars record illegal parking, so they have the evidence to hand out £70 fines to drivers so please park responsibly, particularly around the 'School Keep Clear' road markings – see poster for more information. Whilst on the subject of parking, please do not use the school car park, as this is for staff and visitors only.

## Do not park on schookeep clear markings

Our CCTV car is now out patrolling Nottinghamshire schools to help discourage dangerous and inconsiderate parking.

Motorists caught parking on restricted areas near schools or in bus stops will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) of £70.



Reep clear markings can seriously endanger road safety for children. Please only park in marked areas and help us keep our school children safe.
