Dear Parents and Carers,

The school has always worked hard to have strong links with our parents/carers and the wider community and it has been a pleasure to see you all in school for Parents Evenings, Assemblies, supporting children at sporting competitions and reading with Children. It finally feels like we have returned to normal after the disruption Covid caused.

Since September the children have also enjoyed visits to the Library, Church, and Kingswood, started guitar and ukulele lessons (we are currently looking at drumming and piano lessons - more information to follow), and our plan is to continue offering these extra enhancements to the school curriculum. This term we are looking forward to welcoming you into school for the Parent Forum Meeting, Class 2A Assembly, Book Fair, Christmas Fair and Christmas Performances (there will be a separate letter telling you about all our exciting Christmas activities!). In the new year we also have a range of trips planned.

Every academic year we try to organise at least one trip for each Class per term. Sometimes the trip is a visit to a museum or activity centre, more recently we have arranged for the 'trip' to come to us (e.g., Whitepost Farm brought some animals to visit Key Stage 1). If a visitor comes to us there is no need to book an expensive bus for all the children and so we can make the whole experience cheaper. Learning outside the classroom or in a workshop format is a valuable and effective means of extending pupil knowledge, enriching pupil understanding and promoting personal and social development. We encourage educational visits/or experiences for all our pupils and hope that parents will recognise the value and importance of these visits or events and give their full support. We understand that life is getting expensive right now and bills are soaring, so we will endeavour to keep costs low. However, if we don't get enough money in to cover the trip, we may have to reduce what we do. Please talk to us if you are struggling to pay for trips, we can offer payment plans to help out.

Currently we have the following trips planned:

- Year 5/6 Vikings Day (14th November 2022 in school £4.10)
- Year 3/4 Time Travelling visit to Southwell Minster (28th February 2023 at Southwell £ to be advised)
- Year 5/6 Greek Day (20th March 2023 in school £5.45)
- Year 3/4 Rand Farm (May 2023- at Rand Farm £105.00)

Our Defibrillator appeal started on Tuesday this week and we have been blown away by the support you and our local community have shown. Our aim to provide a defibrillator on Cross Street will benefit the whole community, whilst being a lasting legacy for Erica Tayor, one of our amazing parents who sadly passed away earlier this term. The target on the JustGiving page has already been met, so we are being a bit cheeky and now plan to try and raise funds for 2 machines- one for the front entrance and one for the back entrance to school. Please share our plans far and wide and thank anyone who has support our appeal. Together we really can achieve great things.

(for classes 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d, 2e, 2f)


