
Mobile Phone Policy - Now in force

Key Stage 2 Music Lessons



Children in Key Stage 2 have the opportunity to take music lessons (piano and guitar).

Piano lesson slots are currently fully booked but should spaces become available we will advise parents.

There are, however, a limited number of guitar lesson slots) that are being offered to children in class 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d and 2e.

- Lessons are ongoing throughout the school year.
- Lessons take place during the school day (your child will miss part of a regular lesson, break or lunchtime).
 - Fees are be paid directly to the external music provider (in advance), not to the school.
 - Pupils may only sign up for one music lesson during school time.

- Children that signed up for guitar or piano in the last academic year will be able to continue if they wish.
 - Please note that places are limited so we cannot guarantee your child will be successful should they apply for lessons
 - Each weekly lesson will be 30 minutes long (guitar is on a Tuesday).
 - Guitar Lessons are £22.95 per calendar month.
 - Students may borrow a guitar.
 - If you have any questions about guitar lessons please email admin@wecreatemusic.co.uk

If your child is interested in signing up for a guitar lessons taster please ask the school office for a sign up flyer (we will pass all completed forms to the relevant music provider).

Don't forget, if your child already learns an instrument at school please **do not** sign your child up for another instrument .

What's New with MCAS

Move from ParentPay to MCAS for all school payments and bookings





Please ensure you read the document below carefully, as there have been a lot of changes with the way parents pay and order things.

Link to School Payments Update (PDF document)

The key points are:

- NEW Parents need to order tuck in advance using MCAS and toast is now the only option for tuck. Children will not be given tuck unless it has been ordered on MCAS.
- NEW You now need to book into Arnie's Breakfast Club (the paid club) using MCAS
 - **NEW** Please book into Millie's After School Clubs using MCAS
 - Please book into the 30-minute free breakfast club using MCAS
 - School meal balances should now be paid onto MCAS.
 - All trips will now be payable via MCAS.
 - ParentPay is no longer being used for anything.



Have you booked your wraparound care for this week?



If you are wishing your child to stay for the following wraparound care, this needs to be booked and paid for via MCAS:

- 30-minute free breakfast club
- Arnie's paid breakfast club (7.45-9.00am (£3.50 per session)
- Millie's Afterschool Club until 4.30pm (£5.00 per session)
- Millie's Afterschool Club until 6.00pm (£12.00 per session - includes light tea)
