Tax Free Childcare Payments back up and running





We are pleased to say that we have finally got our Tax Free Childcare payments back up and running with all providers. We apologise again for the time this has taken to sort this out, but this has been completely out of our control.

You can pay for Arnie's Breakfast Club, Millie's Afterschool Clubs and the 30-minute extra childcare for full time nursery children (this will be billed after half term). Each time you make a payment, we would ask that you complete this form:

Important things to note:

 Balances will only reach your MCAS account once we have received confirmation from the finance department that the funds have reached the school bank account this is likely to take approximately a week.

- There is a minimum payment of £10 due to the administration involved you can pay in advance and keep the money on the account
 - Please ensure that you include your reference number on the form so that finance can trace your payment - they receive hundreds of payments into their bank account which would be impossible to trace without the reference number.

Friends of Arnold Mill PTFA Halloween Colouring Competition




The Friends of Arnold Mill PTFA (FOAM) love Halloween and have decided to hold a themed children's colouring competition.

Urgent Safeguarding Alert

We have been made aware that several titles in the Spy Dogs, Spy Pup, and Spy Cat series by Andrew Cope contain a weblink at the back of the book that no longer directs people to information about the books. Instead, the link has been compromised and now leads to inappropriate and unsafe material, containing pornographic content with no age restrictions.

We have removed copies of the book from our school library and classroom book corners.

Sadly, as a school we generate **LOTS** of lost property. To try and reduce the amount of lost property this academic year we are asking parents to:

- ensure that your child doesn't bring toys and/or valuable items or things that are not needed for school.


