The school council are looking at items of equipment that they would like for the playground so we will be looking to see if the funds we raise can help them buy the things the children choose.

We are also looking to hold some cinema nights and a table top sale so keep a look out for details in newsletters, on the Facebook page & the website. Last year we provided refreshments for parents at the school sports day and as this went so well we will be making this an annual event that we support. The school will continue to run the Christmas & Summer fairs and we will support them in whatever way they want us to.

At the end of last term we held a very successful unwanted shoe donation day for the Unicef Shoe Share Scheme. We took over 90 pairs of shoes to our local Clarkes store which will mean that 90 children will now be in receipt of books & pens. Rather than wait until the end of the school year we are going to incorporate this as part of the new trial for keeping on top of lost property which we know is an issue for nearly every parent in the school.

Lost Property

The school will be providing 3 bins for lost property so that tops, bottoms and other items get separated to make it easier to look for lost items.

Volunteers from the PTA will sort through items 2 weeks prior to each half term and return anything that is labelled. Then each week prior to a half term volunteers will be in reception from 8.30-9.00 & 3.30-4.00 for you to come & see if you can locate any lost items, we will have items in age group order to try and make your task as easy as possible. We will also have pens available for you to label items up.

If you would like to donate any uniform items that you no longer need including any shoes we will have collection boxes available.

Our first trial of this will be from Monday 16th October-Friday 20th October.
