

Since September, Mrs Monaghan, Mrs Hopewell, Mrs Rose and Mrs Smith have all been using the Den to support children with interventions. Having a place separate to the main school building has been incredible, especially providing a new space for children with emotional needs to feel comfortable opening up away from the busy school building.

In December, we were lucky to use some money from the Christmas fair to begin Phase 2 of the development and added a Swedish Climbing Wall (see above picture) to help children to release their energy by channeling it into a productive outlet.
