Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 1 visit to Stonebridge City Farm - Friday 24th June 2022

In support of our curriculum topics for the summer term, 'Growing and Animals' we will be visiting Stonebridge City Farm (during normal school hours). During the visit the children will have the opportunity to feed the animals, take part in a themed farm tour, enjoy a creepy crawly hunt and garden activities led by the farm staff.



The whole school cost of the day is £450 and includes transport and a full day of activities. This represents excellent value for money. The school is asking for a contribution of just £10.00 per child which should be paid via your child's ParentPay account please.

Contributions for Trips and Activities - we believe in the value of these experiences and try to ensure that these opportunities are accessible and affordable to all. However, the school does not have the financial resources to pay the full cost of every trip/activity. Your child will not be excluded if you are unable to contribute. However, please note that without such contributions, trips and activities may have to be cancelled, due to a lack of funds. Please also bear in mind that the school staff run non curriculum After School Clubs at the end of the school day, something which we could charge for but, to date, have not. We aim to give the children the best possible chances in their education whilst trying to balance the cost for both ourselves and parents. I hope that you will support us in this and that this paragraph has clarified contributions for trips and activities.

Useful Information

 As your child is entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals, Mrs Knight will provide a packed lunch. Your child will, however, need a drink (no fizzy drinks please) and small rucksack to put their lunch in please.

- The children must come in their school uniform but can wear trainers or suitable footwear for walking around the City Farm. If the weather is hot, please ensure they are wearing sun cream and a sunhat. As we will be outside, please send them with an extra layer, in just in case it feels chilly in the shade.
- If your child needs to take any medication with them on this trip (such as inhalers, hay fever medicine and travel sickness tablets) you need to:
 - Fill out a separate form for each medicine (one copy attached, please contact the school office if you need additional form(s))
 - On the morning of the trip please hand the completed form and the medication (in a clear sandwich bag with your child's name on it) to the Teacher. They will be located in class 1a between 8.45am and 9.00am
 - If your child has/needs an inhaler, please make sure that you send one to school on the day the trip departs
- We will be returning at 3pm, depending on traffic, so please pick your child up at normal time from their classroom.

If you have any questions about the day, please talk to your child's teacher.
