Class 2C (Year 4) Swimming

This term the Year 4 children in 2C will be going swimming at Carlton Forum Leisure Centre. We will be going there by bus, which is provided by the Local Authority.

The swimming sessions start on <u>Friday 11^{TH} June 2021</u> and will be between 10.45am and 11.45 am. There are 7 sessions with the last session currently booked in for 23^{rd} July 2021.

Your child does need to wear school uniform on swimming days. Please can you ensure your child brings their costume and towel in a separate bag.

The Local Education Authority issue rules regarding swimming costumes which are as follows:

- Girls one piece swimming costume
- Boys swimming trunks or close fitting shorts without side pockets and no longer than mid-thigh length (see attached sheet) - please see
 Mrs Greentree if you are unsure.
- Hair which is longer than jaw length should be tied back or in a cap.
- All jewellery must be removed. Ear rings cannot be taped over or covered by a hat.
- Goggles can be worn. However, it is the responsibility of the parent/carer to adjust and fit the goggles correctly and to write a letter of consent to the class teacher.

Please adhere to the regulations, as the instructors will not let your child swim if they break the rules


Enclosure: Swimwear guidance note

Swimwear

Boys require tight fitting trucks or shorts with no pockets and which are no longer than mid thigh length. Those pupils wearing "jammers" will be ok. Acceptable boy's swimwear is shown below:



Girls require a one piece swim suit which is again tight fitting and unrevealing. Acceptable girls' swimwear is shown below:
