Other helpful hints

- We have P.E. on **Tuesday morning** and **Friday afternoon** every week. You will need come to school dressed ready for P.E for these sessions.
 - Please bring a bag **every day**. You will need at least 1 set of spare clothes in case of changing.
 - We have so much fun in F1 and sometimes our activities can be messy, so please bare this in mind when choosing clothes for the session.
 - Please label **ALL** clothing and belongings e.g. bags, coats, hats, shoes.
 - You will need a pair of wellies to leave in school.
 - We access the outdoors every day, please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.
 - Bring a labelled water bottle every day (no juice or flavoured water)
 - If your child would like milk this needs to be ordered online each term.
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- As the rest of school finishes at 3.30pm, we offer the option for 30-hour children to stay until 3.30pm to coordinate with the normal end of the school day, particularly useful for parents with more than one child at school. This will cost £2.50 per day, and we ask that parents choose a regular collection time of either 3.00pm or 3.30pm, for consistency of the children and staff.
 - The 30-hour children will stay for lunch. They need to bring a packed lunch.
