Due to health and safety reasons relating to the number of people in the Hall we have to limit the number of guests for the assembly to two per child. To ensure that we can set out the correct number of guest chairs for the assembly please confirm the name of your child's guest (please complete and submit the booking form by clicking on this link [click here](#) by midnight on Wednesday 8th October. We will not be issuing physical tickets as the booking form enables us to produce the guest list.

We would like to clarify the arrangements for the day as follows:

- Doors open for guests at approx. 9.05am and the assembly is due to start at 9.10am
- Please note that the pedestrian gate on Bestwood Avenue is locked at 9.15am and will remain locked until 3.15pm.
- No buggies/pushchairs in the Hall during the assembly please (they can be left in the lobby area but please make sure they do not block the Emergency/Fire exit route)
- The staff car park gate will remain locked if the gate happens to be open please do not park in the car park as you risk being locked in until the staff leave once they have tidied up at the end of the performance.
