To help my child at school, I know & understand that:

- If I, or my child shows symptoms of Covid-19, I will not come to school. We will all self isolate as a family and arrange a test. If the test is negative, my child may return back to school. If the test is positive, the Bubble will be shut down. If my child shows symptoms during the school day, I will be informed and expected to pick up immediately and arrange a test.
- When dropping my child off & picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules, observing the routes marked out around the school site
- When dropping off & picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- My child must not bring any items into school apart from a named water bottle and / or a lunchbox.
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules.
- My child will need to follow good hygiene rules at all times. If they do not, they may be asked to stay at home.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a prearranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create a 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parent / carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home & cannot return to school until they can be safe.

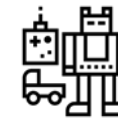
I will do my best to:
