HISTORY

Our unit this half term is, 'The Gunpowder Plot'. We will begin by looking at a time line to see how long ago 1605 was. They will read about and discuss the treatment of Catholics to decide if it was fair or unfair. The children will role play and imagine that we are Catholic in 1605. In groups they will discuss ways they could get James the 1st to listen. They will evaluate the options and debate each of them. We will then continue to read about what happened and write recounts of the Gunpowder Plot.

SCIENCE

We will be learning about 'Materials' and 'Recycling' during science this half term! We will investigate materials and their uses.
