Get set... we're taking part in Sustrans Bike to School Week 2020, which is designed to showcase the benefits of cycling to school across the UK. This event has been extremely successful in previous years and we had a huge number of children pedalling to school.

The challenge runs from 28th September to 2nd October 2020.

Bike to School Week is a great opportunity to promote the positive impact that an active lifestyle can have on pupils' wellbeing and health. It's free to enter and we would love everyone to be involved, as it's a fantastic way to get us warmed up ready for the Sustrans Big Pedal in the spring.

The details

During Bike to School Week we ask teachers to encourage pupils, parents and staff to cycle to school. On each day of the challenge schools compete to see who can record the greatest number of pupils, staff and parents cycling or scooting to school. We'll be competing against other schools right across the UK, and if we clock up the most bike and scooter journeys we'll win!

Why we're taking part

It's a great way to get more of our pupils travelling to school on their bikes and scooters.

What's next?

All you need to do is encourage your child(ren) to cycle or scoot to school every day during the event, and join them on their way – parent and sibling journeys count too!
