Explain that you are going to Choose children to come to the front and whisper to them an animal that you want them to act out. Choose ¾ at a time and let them use actions and noises to represent that animal. Ask children to guess which animal they were. Once they are all guessed ask how easy they think it is to act out the part of an animal. Its easy for a few minutes but imagine if you had to keep it up for a whole day, month or year?! 
