Mon 17 th April	Love learning	Love	Inspired and Excited to Learn	Friday- Earth Day	<p>We are focusing on our star quality love. Our school vision states that all that we do should be done in love. What does that mean? (Record in scrap book)</p> <p>Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-8, 12-13</p> <p>Paul wrote this about how people should live. He uses the word “Love” around 10 times, ending up by saying it is the most important thing.</p> <p>Ask children what they think love looks like. (record)</p> <p>Paul makes it clear that love is about what we can give to others. It's about wanting the best for someone and putting others first. Can children think of some examples of this?</p> <p>Reflection- Play Brother Sister let me serve you song lyrics - YouTube</p> <p>End with prayer</p>	The parable of the Prodigal Son – linking to ‘ Love our family ’	Eco club



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<p>Mon 24th April</p>	<p>Love learning</p>	<p>Love</p>	<p>Inspired and Excited to Learn</p>	<p>This week we are thinking about our star quality love. One of the ways in which we can show love is by listening to people and sharing their worries.</p> <p>Ask children who they can talk to about their worries. Encourage children to think about the breaktime buddies and using the reflection area.</p> <p>Explain to children if it hasn't already come up in conversation that Christians believe that God is always there to listen to us and take away our worries if we share them with him. Christians believe that God cares about us more than anyone else.</p> <p>Read together: Psalm 34:17 (Put this quote in scrap book)</p> <p>What do we think that means? What does it suggest we do when we are troubled?</p> <p>Reflection - play sea sounds music and ask children to imagine something that is worrying them being washed away at sea.</p> <p>End with a prayer</p>	<p>'Love ourselves' We are made & loved by God Psalm 139 1 John 3.1 (HW)</p>	<p>Swift Class</p>

What do they like doing there?</p> <p>Read Luke 19 1-8 together. (KS2) Read Jesus and the Taxman- Liontellers Bible. (KS1)</p> <p>Reflection- what effect did the party have on Zacchaeus?</p> <p>End with a prayer.</p>	Creation story from Genesis 1:1 – 2:3 linking to 'Love our environment'	Ethos team

It takes a lot of patience! Mon 15 th May	Love learning	Patience	Inspired and Excited to Learn		<p>This term we are thinking about our value of loving learning.</p> <p>Involve the children in a game of hangman. After a few goes ask how do we learn to play games? Take answers for scrap book. (Watch other people, get told, learn as we play etc) Is it always fun to learn new things? Some things are more difficult to learn- can anyone think of any examples (times tables?)</p> <p>Read Luke 2:52 together.</p> <p>What sort of things do you think Jesus had to learn as a child? What does wisdom mean? Can you think of some examples? Can you imagine Jesus as a child? What do you think he was like? What does patience look like you to you? (Record in scrap book)</p> <p>Read Luke 15:11-24 together KS2 Read the Big spender (Lion tells Bible) KS1</p> <p>How did the dad show patience? Do you think his dad was right to forgive him? Ask children for suggestions of things to do for other people. (Letting people in front of you in a queue, offering to clear away for someone, smiling) Challenge the children to choose one act a day and complete it.</p>		Otter Class

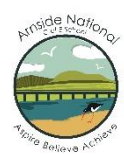
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					<p>Together read: Ephesians 4:32 (Record in scrap book)</p> <p>What do you think it means? Is kindness just about being nice and doing helpful things?</p> <p>Reflection- think of a way to show kindness to someone who isn't always kind to you.</p> <p>End with a prayer</p>	
Monday 12 th June	Love our neighbours	Kindness	Part of a team.	<p>Sports week</p> <p>Monday- sports day</p>	<p>This term we are thinking about being part of a team.</p> <p>Ask the children to think back to the story of the 3 kings travelling to meet Jesus. What dangers might they have faced? Was it important that they all got on well together?</p> <p>Read- Matthew 2:1-3, 7-12 together.</p> <p>Ask children- why did the wise men go to Herod first? Why didn't they go back and tell Herod that they had found Jesus? How would you have felt if you were one of the wise men? Do you think it would have been good to be part of the group? 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					<p>how it made the job they were doing easier.</p> <p>End with a prayer.</p>	
Monday 19 th June	Love our neighbours	Kindness	Part of a team.		<p>This term we are thinking about the part of our school vision that says we love our neighbours.</p> <p>Ask children to think of some qualities that make a good friend. (record)</p> <p>Explain that even though all these words are positive sometimes friendships can be a bit difficult. Ask children how you can sort things out if you fall out with a friend. Talk to the children about how the tough times can make friendships stronger.</p> <p>Read Proverbs 17:17 together. "A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity."</p> <p>Explain that adversity means tough times. Can children think of a time that tough times made their friendships closer?</p> <p>Reflection- think of how you can be a good friend.</p> <p>End with a prayer.</p>	Hedgehog class

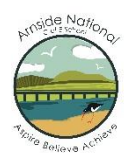


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Monday 26 th June	Love our neighbours	Love	Part of a team.		<p>We are focusing on our star quality love.</p> <p>Ask children to think about people they love. Take comments for scrap book. Ask children does everybody who you love, love you? The general answer is yes.</p> <p>Explain that it is usually easy to love the people who love us- family and friends. But Christians believe that Jesus said:</p> <p>“if you just love those who love you, what more are you doing than any other people do?”</p> <p>Discuss this with the children.</p> <p>Read the good Samaritan story with children (Luke 10:25-37 or we have a story book in my classroom if you would prefer.)</p> <p>Ask children to think of someone who had been mean to them. Imagine a situation where they needed your help. Would you give it to them? (Take comments)</p>		Butterfly class
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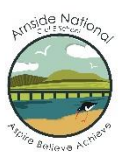

Monday 3 rd July	Love our neighbours	Love	Part of a team.		<p>Remind children that we are thinking about being part of a team.</p> <p>Ask children who can speak another language. Or if they have anyone at home who can speak another language.</p> <p>If anyone can speak another language invite them to the front and ask them to teach the class a phrase like “good morning” or “how are you?”</p> <p>If there is no one in your class, use google translate to translate some phrases into different languages.</p> <p>Explain that Christians believe that God created so many different languages for people to speak because it is fun to learn from each other.</p> <p>KS2 Read Acts 2:1-11 in own Bibles.</p>	Swift Class

Explain that change can sometimes be good, bad, exciting, scary etc but having a positive attitude can help us deal with these new experiences.</p> <p>Read Mark 1:16-20 together. (KS2 find in Bible)</p> <p>Do children think it would have been hard for Simon and Andrew to leave home and follow Jesus? Why do you think they did it ? What helps us in times of change?</p> <p>Reflection- Think of a change that's happened to you and who has helped you.</p> <p>End with a prayer.</p>	Osprey Class
