Drawing on Teddy's knowledge of the outdoors, the pages of the sketchbooks have been carefully transcribed for young readers, as they were originally intended.

Cal Major is an ocean advocate, world-record stand up paddle boarder and veterinary surgeon. She founded Paddle Against Plastic in 2016 to bring a positive message to the plastic pollution crisis and to inspire and empower positive change through stand up paddle boarding adventures.

Her 2018 expedition saw her SUP the length of the UK, from Land's End to John O'Groats; she was awarded the Prime Minister's Points of Light award on World Oceans Day to celebrate her campaigns and efforts to conserve our oceans.
