

Read the poem, 'At the Zoo'. You may have a school reading book to read or a book from Oxford Owls or Epic.





Topic – Climate Fairtrade and You!

What is the weather and climate like in different areas of Earth? And why?

What is weather? (Look at weather collected on 'my-weather-record-activity-sheet' since Monday on the weather record sheet and discuss with your adult)



What is climate?

Geography KS1/KS2: Climate - BBC Teach

Look at 'Thursday topic photo', this is a farmer.

What type of farmer do you think this is? What is growing on this farmer's farm? Where in the world is this? What do you think the temperature is like in this photograph? Could this photograph be in the UK? Why do you think this?

We are going to find out about the different climates in the UK, and in the cocoa growing region of West Africa. Watch this three-minute film

What are the differences between these two climates? What are the similarities?

Find, 'Thursday topic compare climate of Cote d'Ivoire and UK' can you draw and write these differences and similarities? Remember to record the types of agriculture in these two climates. Now use a different coloured pen or pencil to record the effects of the climate crisis on their Venn diagram. How are temperate climates affected by the climate crisis? How are tropical rainforest climates affected by the climate crisis?



We are going to play Times Tables Bingo using the 2 times tables, 5 times tables and 10 times tables.




