In the Reception, Early Years Foundation Stage Profile (EYFSP) 67% of pupils made a 'good level of development' (GLD). These judgements have been moderated by the Local Authority (LA). This is a wonderful foundation for our younger pupils to build upon. Note: 1 pupil = 11%

In the Year 1 phonics test, 87% of pupils gained the expected level. Note: 1 pupil = 6%

KS1 Teacher assessment (TA) outcomes take into account the results of statutory tests in English reading and mathematics. For this cohort of pupils, the whole of KS1 has been disrupted by Covid and the estimated National outcomes reflect the widescale drop in attainment.
