Dear parent / carer

There are many levels of statutory assessment in school, from Nursery up to Year 6. We have had good results across all areas in school which shows strength in depth throughout the classes.

In the Reception, Early Years Foundation Stage Profile (EYFSP) 78% of pupils made a 'good level of development' (GLD). These judgements have been moderated by the Local Authority (LA). This is a wonderful foundation for our younger pupils to build upon. Note: 1 pupil = 11%

In the Year 1 phonics test, 91% of pupils gained the expected level. Note: 1 pupil = 9%
