Years 1 & 2 (Year A)	Explore & Draw Introducing the idea that artists can be collectors & explorers as they develop drawing and composition skills.	Inspired by Flora & Fauna Explore how artists make art inspired by flora and fauna. Make collages of Minibeasts and display as a shared artwork.	Making Birds Sculptural project beginning with making drawings from observation, exploring media, and transforming the drawings from 2d to 3d to make a bird.
Years 1 & 2 (Year B)	Spirals Using drawing, collage and mark-making to explore spirals. Introducing sketchbooks.	Exploring the World Through Mono Print Using a simple mono print technique to develop drawing skills, encourage experimentation and ownership.	Stick Transformation Project  Explore how you can transform a familiar object into new and fun forms.
Years 3, 4 & 5 (Year A)	Gestural Drawing with Charcoal  Making loose, gestural drawings with charcoal, and exploring drama and performance.	Exploring Still Life  Explore artists working with the genre of still life, contemporary and more traditional. Create your own still life inspired art work	Telling Stories Through Making  Explore how artists are inspired by other art forms — in this case how we make sculpture inspired by literature and film.
Years 3, 4 & 5 (Year B)	Typography & Maps Exploring how we can create typography through drawing and design, and use our skills to create personal and highly visual maps.	Working with Shape and Colour  "Painting with Scissors": Collage and stencil in response to looking at artwork.	Sculpture, Structure, Inventiveness & Determination What can artists learn from nature?
Years 3, 4 & 5 (Year C)	Storytelling Through Drawing Explore how artists create sequenced drawings to share and tell stories. Create accordion books or comic strips to retell poetry or prose through drawing.	Fashion Design  Explore contemporary fashion designers and create your own 2d or 3d fashion design working to a brief.	Festival Feasts  How might we use food and art to bring us together?
Years 6 (Year A)	2D Drawing to 3D Making  Explore how 2D drawings can be transformed to 3D objects. Work towards a sculptural outcome or a graphic design outcome	Activism  Explore how artists use their skills to speak on behalf of communities. Make art about things you care about.	Take a Seat  Explore how craftspeople and designers bring personality to their work.
