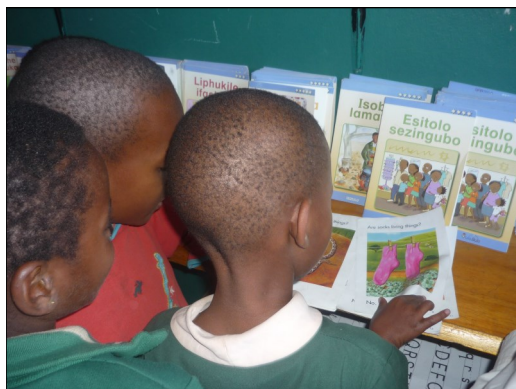


Carlisle Diocese visit to Zululand Diocese Post visit update

Dear Church Schools,



After the most amazing, yet humbling visit to Zululand schools we wanted to update you with where we are up to. We visited five, very different, schools across the region, High schools, primary schools, rural schools, a church school, town schools, fee paying and Government schools. We were welcomed, sung to and danced for. The over riding feeling we came away with was one of difference. The difference within their system; how some schools have everything they need and some have barely anything. But all were excited about the possibilities of building relationships with our schools. We have identified which schools here would link successfully and reciprocally with a Zululand school and will contact those schools who expressed an interest, as soon as we have produced guidelines to safeguard you in doing this. We will also provide an update at the [Education Conference](#) in September, but feel strongly that this is the start of a really good two-way relationship. Over the next few months, we will be producing materials and resources that will help you to teach your children not only about life in Zululand for children but also about Christian faith in a multi-cultural community at an International level.
