

ORANGE tasks My Instant Recall Rainbow Targets

NB: These are activities to try at home to help towards your child's maths target, these are just examples please practise in as many different ways as possible as this will reinforce and consolidate understanding of each target.

a.) To recognise the value of all coins up to 10p

Task: Show children the different coins up to 10p and children to name.

Role play shopkeepers and customer, children to pay with correct coins and look at making value with different coins e.g. $10 \times 1p = 10p$

b.) To know all the number facts that make the story 4

Task: Create a story using the number facts to make the story of 4, ($4 + 0$; $3 + 1$; $2 + 2$; $1 + 3$; $0 + 4$)

E.g. There were 3 little girls and 1 other girl joined them, then there were 4.


c.) To know all the number facts that make the story 5

Task: Create a story using the number facts to make the story of 5, ($5 + 0$; $4 + 1$; $3 + 2$; $2 + 3$; $1 + 4$; $0 + 5$)

E.g. There were 3 little ducks gliding in the pond and 2 more ducks joined them, then there were 5 in the pond altogether.

d.) To recognise regular 3d shapes (cube, cuboid, cone, sphere and cylinder)

Activity: Children to name the shapes below. Encourage children to find these shapes in their house, garden and local area.



e.) To know all the number facts that make the story 6

Task: Create a story using the number facts to make the story of 6, ($6 + 0$; $5 + 1$; $4 + 2$; $3 + 3$; $2 + 4$; $1 + 5$; $0 + 6$)

E.g. There were 2 sausages sizzling in the pan and 4 more were put in, now there are 6 sizzling sausages.

f.) To answer a selection of questions based on the above orange targets

Activity: Complete a mixture of the above activities to reinforce understanding.
