A huge thank you to all of our staff for everything that they have done during the hot weather this week.

Preparation for the School Day

Children should arrive at school fully prepared with everything they need for the day. We are currently seeing a significant increase in interruptions to the school office with items such as hats, sun cream and lunch boxes, which can disrupt the smooth running of the school day.

Remember to send your child to school prepared for the warm weather - Checklist

- Send your child to school with a hat (named)
- Send your child to school with a water bottle (named)
- Apply sun cream before school.

Children may bring sun cream (named) to apply it themselves. We simply ask that it is kept safely in their bag and that children do not share it or apply it to others, as we need to be mindful of potential allergies.

Some families find that roll-on sun cream is a helpful option for children to use independently.

Remember to cancel School Dinner if off Poorly

Remember to cancel your child's school dinner on SchoolGrid if they are off poorly. You have until 8.45am on the day of absence otherwise you will still be charged.

General Reminders

For the safety of all our children, parents and carers please can we remind you that children not allowed to ride bikes and scooters in the playground.

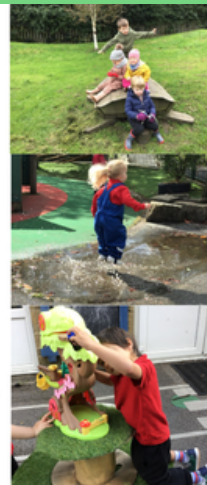

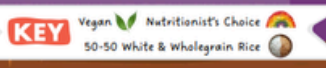
