Practise spelling the Year 1 Common Exception Words. These will be sent home each Monday. You could use chalks, paint, water and brushes, a tray of sand or rice or magnetic letters. Can you use the Year 1 words you have been practicing to write a funny sentence?	Encourage your child to read regularly at home.
