Level 3 Award in Education and Training

This is a short course, ideal if you undertake some teaching or training within your work, voluntary or community role, if you want to improve your training and teaching skills or if you are considering a full teacher training course and would like an introduction.

The course will allow you to acquire the necessary skills and knowledge to prepare, plan, deliver and evaluate teaching and learning sessions within your area of expertise such as your work role or subject area. You are not required to be in a teaching role or to obtain formal teaching practice as part of this course. You will demonstrate your teaching or training skills within the course.

This award is made up of 3 units:

- Understanding Roles, Responsibilities and Relationships in Education and Training
- Understanding and Using Inclusive Teaching and Learning Approaches in Education and Training
- Understanding Assessment in Education and Training

Assessment is mainly through course work with the production of a portfolio plus you will lead a mini teaching session within the course, with your peers. If you are employed in a teaching or training role already, you can be observed in your work role if you prefer. Successful completion leads to certification from the awarding body BTEC.

In addition to the teaching and learning activities and support in the course sessions, you will be expected to engage with online learning activities. You can obtain additional learning support for any specific learning needs you may have with the college's Inclusive Learning Team, please discuss your learning needs with a tutor prior to enrolment. This year, we are implementing a remote session on Friday mornings.
