### Coming soon—Return to Study short course

Have you ever wondered what it's like to study in Adult and Higher education? Maybe you want to return to education but are worried you don't have the right skills and qualifications? Well, you have come to the right place. We are offering a new short taster course to help you develop your confidence and skills. Our Higher and Adult Education courses are designed to help you figure out where you want to be and point you in the right direction to get there.

### How will the Higher and Adult Education courses help me?

You don't necessarily need certain qualifications to apply, and many who complete our courses go on to foundation or degree-level programmes. This course will help you with:

- A career change or developing your skills and gaining the qualifications if you want to move up the job ladder
- Develop your academic writing, referencing, and critical thinking skills.
- Finding your feet again if you have been out of education for a long time.
- Meet like-minded students and get a feel for life at Ashton Sixth Form College.

### Coming soon—Essential Digital Skills course

An estimated one in five adults lack basic digital skills. To address this skills gap, from August 2020 the Department for Education (DfE) is introducing an entitlement for adults to fully-funded digital skills qualifications.

These digital skills qualifications will be targeted at adults aged 19+ and are intended to support adults to help develop the digital skills they need for life, work or further study.

From January 2021, this course will offer adults the opportunity to develop their digital skills with the Essential Digital Skills qualification. Students will be assessed in line with the national standards for Essential Digital Skills that cover five skills areas. The qualifications will be available at Entry, Level 3 and Level I.

- Using devices and handling information Understanding hardware, software and operating systems.
- Communicating Understand how to communicate effectively using electronic communications such as email and video calls.
- Creating and editing Creating different types of digital media such as images, videos and audio files.
- Being safe and responsible online Understand the importance of your digital wellbeing and learn about privacy and data protection.
- Transacting Understand how to purchase an item or using a service. This includes digital verification checks and successfully completing online forms.

### New course—ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages)

Are you an Adult who needs to learn English and work in the UK? Our new ESOL course will help you improve your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in English. By taking this course, you will be able to fully interact with people in your everyday life, such as going to a supermarket. The communication barrier can make life difficult therefore this course will help your life easier by alleviating miscommunication and creating more opportunities for you.

### Why should I take this course?

This course will be designed to provide you with all-round fundamental skills of English across five levels, along with verbal skills and useful phrases that will help you communicate effectively in English when in a professional environment.

The English language is one of the most commonly spoken languages and is often considered the most influential language in the world. This versatile language is also used across multiple mediums to educate, entertain and inform people globally.

So, whether you want to learn English to further your studies, your career, or your personal horizons, there are many benefits you can gain from taking this course.

- English is very popular worldwide.
- English will help you understand other languages.

- Jobs are always available for English speakers. If you can speak English, you will be presented with a world of opportunities will for travel, study and work.

### **Fees**

Wherever possible, all the costs related to a course are listed in this guide. If you are paying the full course fees then this will cover the whole cost of your course including tuition and exam fees. You will be able to obtain more information about individual course fees at our Enrolment Events.

### **Financial Assistance**

If you are in receipt of active, income based benefits or in receipt of a low income then you may be eligible for a reduction in your course fees. This only applies to some courses.

### If you are interested in Maths and English Functional skills

You can complete these courses for free if you have been a UK resident or have been in a European Economic Area (EEA) or EU resident for the past 3 years.

### If you are interested in a Level 2 course

You may be entitled to free tuition if you have not previously achieved a full level 2 qualification. A full level 2 is the equivalent of five GCSE passes at grade A\*-C, 4-9, or an NVQ level 2.

### If you are 19 and over and interested in a Level 3 course

You can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover the cost of your course. It's easy to apply, your household income isn't taken into account and there's no credit check. For more information log onto www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan.

To enrol, please bring with you your passport or birth certificate and National Insurance number. If you are claiming fee remission you will need to bring all documentation with you.

You must comply with the Fees Agency residency/settled status criteria requested at enrolment and are not repeating learning already undertaken to achieve a qualification.
