New course—ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages)

Are you an Adult who needs to learn English and work in the UK? Our new ESOL course will help you improve your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in English. By taking this course, you will be able to fully interact with people in your everyday life, such as going to a supermarket. The communication barrier can make life difficult therefore this course will help your life easier by alleviating miscommunication and creating more opportunities for you.

Why should I take this course?

This course will be designed to provide you with all-round fundamental skills of English across five levels, along with verbal skills and useful phrases that will help you communicate effectively in English when in a professional environment.

The English language is one of the most commonly spoken languages and is often considered the most influential language in the world. This versatile language is also used across multiple mediums to educate, entertain and inform people globally.

So, whether you want to learn English to further your studies, your career, or your personal horizons, there are many benefits you can gain from taking this course.

New course— Access to HE in Education (Diploma)

This Level 3 course will prepare you for academic study for a degree in Education, Childhood Studies, Early Years Education, and Primary Education or other related education career pathways.

This course is aimed at students with an interest in careers in education and related disciplines. The Access to HE Diploma will provide you with the equivalent of three A Levels and the skills needed to apply for a Higher Education qualification. This course prepares you for academic study for a degree in Education, Childhood Studies, Early Years Education and Primary Education or other related education career pathways. The broad-based but relevant course content is designed to increase your knowledge and skills enabling you to return to study as a confident and independent learner.

The qualification also enables progression to a whole range of Level 4 programmes including higher apprenticeships. Access students can apply for a place at a Higher Education Institution using the usual UCAS application process with the majority successfully gaining a place onto a variety of education related degrees such as: • Teaching • Early Years Educator • Other education -related degrees, perfect for those who want a change of career or who aspire to become an education professional. There are no formal entry requirements for this course but an ability to write at level 2 is required.

This course will run over the duration of one academic year and starts in October 2021.

Fees

Wherever possible, all the costs related to a course are listed in this guide. If you are paying the full course fees then this will cover the whole cost of your course including tuition and exam fees. You will be able to obtain more information about individual course fees at our Enrolment Events.

Financial Assistance

If you are in receipt of active, income based benefits or in receipt of a low income then you may be eligible for a reduction in your course fees. This only applies to some courses.

If you are interested in Maths and English Functional skills

You can complete these courses for free if you have been a UK resident or have been in a European Economic Area (EEA) or EU resident for the past 3 years.

If you are interested in a Level 2 course

You may be entitled to free tuition if you have not previously achieved a full level 2 qualification. A full level 2 is the equivalent of five GCSE passes at grade A*-C, 4-9, or an NVQ level 2.

If you are 19 and over and interested in a Level 3 course

You can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover the cost of your course. It's easy to apply, your household income isn't taken into account and there's no credit check. For more information log onto www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan.

To enrol, please bring with you your passport or birth certificate and National Insurance number. If you are claiming fee remission you will need to bring all documentation with you.

You must comply with the Fees Agency residency/settled status criteria requested at enrolment and are not repeating learning already undertaken to achieve a qualification.
