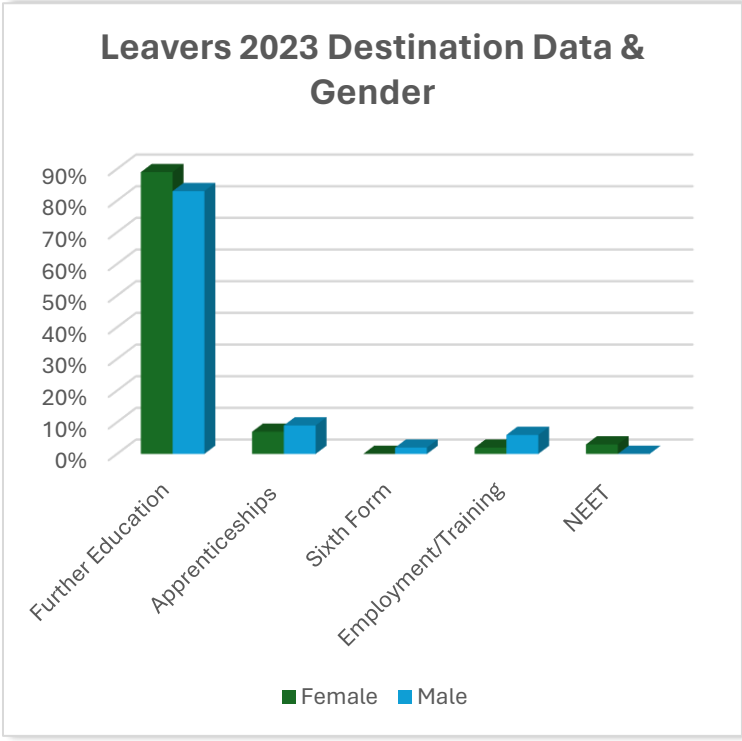


## Current destinations of Year 11 Leavers (2022 & 2023) as of March 2024

Here at Ashton Community Science College, we take pride in the fact that 99% of our 2023 leavers have transitioned into and stayed in positive destinations.

Most of our pupils (86%) have chosen further education colleges to continue with their education; either studying A-levels, BTECs, Diploma's or T-levels.

Alongside this, 8% of our students have secured apprenticeships with local employers. This has remained the same percentage as of our 2022 leavers, which is a positive comparison to the 0% of our 2021 leavers securing an apprenticeship.

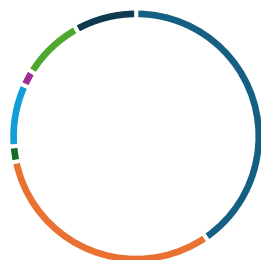

Generally, most of our pupils enrol either at Cardinal Newman (for A-Level, BTEC or T-level Courses) or at Preston College (for BTEC or T-level courses). Our 2023 leavers data saw 29% enrolling at Cardinal Newman and 43% enrolling at Preston College.

This contrasts with our 2022 Leavers, with 31% enrolling at Cardinal Newman and 40% enrolling at Preston College. We also have several enrolments at both Myerscough College and Runshaw College, both with 5% of our students attending.
