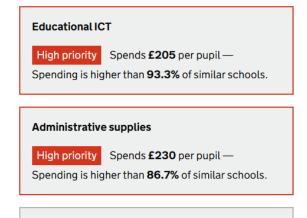

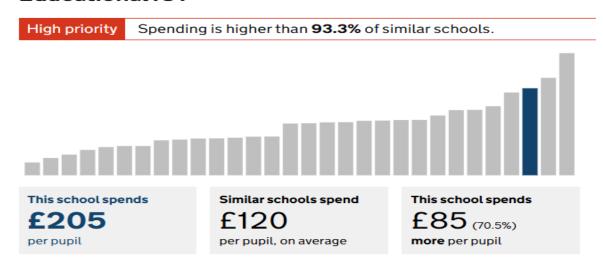

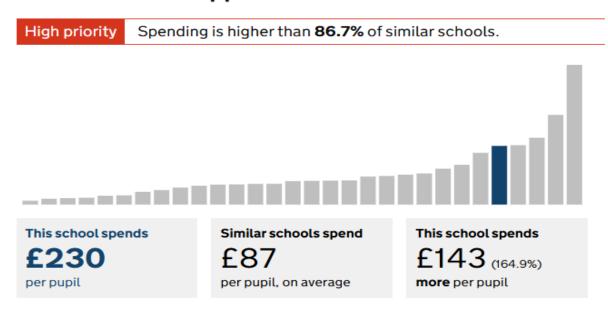
Educational ICT

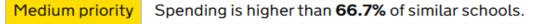
Administrative supplies

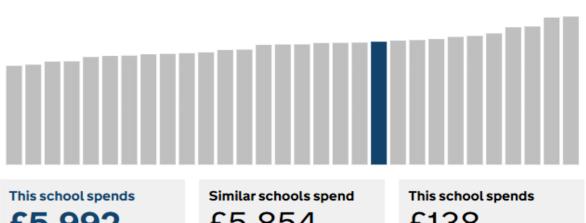
