

Educational visits review

During Term 1, the following visits occurred:

- **Y10/11 Fieldwork in Fleetwood**

The visit is a 'staple', occurring annually.

Evaluation by Miss Williamson: The visit was successful and met the aims of the visit (collecting fieldwork data).

- **DSD visit to Weeton St Michael's Primary School**

An opportunity arose for some of our DSD pupils to take part in delivering an assembly for a local primary school.

Evaluation by Jen against aims: The visit met its aim, but more so was a fantastic opportunity for the students to share deaf awareness with children whose knowledge was limited.

- **Year 11 visit to WW1 Battlefields**

The first of an annual visit to the WW1 Battlefields with Year 11. A very valuable experience for all.

Evaluation by John against aims: Incredible sites visited that massively enhanced the pupils' understanding of the First World War. The pupils visited a range of memorials and cemeteries during the trip. They took part in two acts of remembrance and have a real awareness of the scale of the sacrifice made by a generation of British men.
