




Here at Ashton Community Science College we take pride in the fact that over 97% of our 2022 leavers have transitioned into positive destinations.

These diagrams display how the majority of our pupils have chosen vocational pathways, with 59% choosing to study Diplomas and BTECS. Alongside this, many of our pupils (27%) have taken on studying their favourite subjects at A-level.

We are also pleased to see that a number of our students (7%) have secured apprenticeships, in comparison to 0% of our 2021 leavers.

College Destinations of Leavers

(2022 & 2021)

Generally, the majority of our pupils enrol either at Cardinal Newman (for A-Level and BTEC Courses) or at Preston College (for BTEC courses).

This year's leavers (2022) saw 29% enrolling at Cardinal Newman and 45% enrolling at Preston College. This is in contrast to our 2021 Leavers with 45% enrolling at Cardinal Newman and 37% enrolling at Preston College.

We have additionally seen an increase in enrolments at Runshaw College from 5% in 2021 to 11% this year.

This is alongside an increase in those who are now apprentices (7%) in comparison to having no apprentices the year before.

We are proud of all our leavers and wish them the best of luck with their futures!
