Job description	The role is to support within the Performing Arts Department -within the area of Drama, to help with clubs and performances/shows. You would be expected to offer support with running drama clubs, assisting with younger students learning scripts and rehearsing for shows. You would also be responsible for helping to keep props and costumes cupboards neat and tidy. If you have an interest in production technology and working behind the scenes, you could also assist with lighting and sound equipment, backstage or hair, costumes, props and make-up in school shows.
Leadership skills focus	Approachable and supportive Other students need to feel safe and secure in asking you for help to work on their scripts etc. Effective communication – listening and speaking You will need to be able to communicate with younger students to help run drama clubs and listen carefully to assess each students’ need and be able to explain clearly how or what they need to do. You will also need to be able to communicate with the performing arts staff, to offer your support for events within the department. Problem solving You will need to be able to work out the best way/method of helping younger students perform to the best of their ability. You will also need to help with working out the logistics and details of productions – such as promotions, tickets, costumes, lighting, sound etc.
Key responsibilities	As a student leader for Performing Arts (Drama) you will be expected to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend lunchtime and after school rehearsals for school productions. • Assist in drama clubs. • Help keep equipment within the department neat and tidy and fit for use. Support students by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helping them to learn scripts and preparing for their performance role. • Helping them set up a routine/plan of when and where they will learn their scripts and rehearse at home. • Work with them within drama clubs and rehearsals. • Helping them with their costumes, microphones, make up etc during performances.
