

# Year 5 Autumn Newsletter

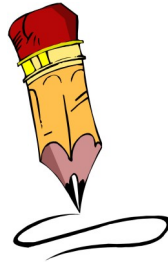


## Maths

## English

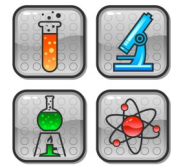
In English we will use the book *Leon and the Place Between* to inspire our narrative writing. Also we write an information text on Earth and Space.

## Humanities
