

Nursery Autumn Newsletter

Our topics this term will be All About Me, Autumn and Day and Night. Through these topics we will cover the 7 areas of learning; Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication and Language, Physical Development, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding of the World and Expressive Arts and Design. Topics are subject to change according to children's interests.



Literacy

In Literacy, we will share a range of stories related to our topics such as, All About Me, The Feelings Book, Owl Babies and How to Catch a Star. We will be using lots of words and phrases from these stories. We will also be exploring mark marking using different tools.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be learning about colour, matching and sorting objects and repeating patterns. We will also be developing our number recognition and language through songs and practical counting activities.



Religious Education

Our topics in RE are Myself, Welcome and Birthdays. We will be learning about the sacrament of Baptism and about the story of Jesus' birthday, Christmas.

Phonics

This term, the emphasis is to get children attuned to the sounds around them.

Physical Development

During our PE sessions we will be developing fundamental skills and movements. Whilst in the Nursery setting we will be supporting the children in moving safely and confidently around the space and having control over a variety of tools and objects.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we will be settling into our Nursery routines, expectations and rules. We will be making new friendships and getting to know each other.

Communication and Language

We will be developing our use and understanding of longer sentences. The children will be encouraged to ask and answer questions and to follow instructions.

Expressive Arts and Design/ Understanding of the World

We will be learning new songs and using different medias to express ourselves. We will be talking about our families and our familiar environments.
