

#### Nicaea 325

This weekend, Pope Leo visits Turkey to commemorate the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea in the year 325AD. If that just seems like ancient history, it was this Council of the Church which was called to settle questions about the divinity of Christ and which produced the Nicene Creed which we say to this day including faith in:

'...one Lord, Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, Begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through Him all things were made.'

We pray for the Holy Father as he undertakes this Apostolic journey and also for the unity of Christians who profess this faith.
