Naapaal Church Building Appeal

Naapaal is a small village in the Upper West Region of Ghana, West Africa.

The community there is Catholic and peasant by way of life. They grow crops and raise livestock to live on, with little or surplus to raise money.

Poor though they are, they are a happy Christian community.

The Church they worship in is built of raw mud and the building is now in a state of collapse.
(there are some pictures on the noticeboard at the back of Church).

The Church community have been trying over the years to raise funds for a block building but, try as they might, they have never been able to achieve it.

Martin and Cecilia Donnir, who are known to many as parishioners at St. Wilfrid's, Our Lady's and St. Oswald's are from Naapaal and attend Mass in the mud Church whenever they go to visit their family. They have undertaken to help the community raise the necessary funds (with a target of £20000) and have asked for our help in order to build a solid brick building with a roof. This will provide a solid structure for the community to worship in, which they hope, over time, to be able to refurbish.

With this in mind, there will be a special retiring collection next weekend after all Masses.

No donation is too small, and anyone who wishes to make a private donation may do so afterwards.
