

Pilgrimage to Ladyewell

As part of our Jubilee celebrations, **next Saturday (17th May)** there will be a pilgrimage to Our Lady's Shrine at Ladyewell, Fernyhalgh, Preston, PR2 5ST.

Ladyewell is one of the most ancient shrines to Our Lady in England, dating from the 11th Century. The day will begin with the Rosary at 11.00am (with a procession from St. Mary's Church for those who are able) followed by Mass at 12 noon. After a packed lunch, there will be the Stations of the Resurrection, and an opportunity to visit the The Reliquary, which houses the Burgess Altar and the relics of several of the Martyrs. We will return home at approximately 3.00pm.

In order that we can notify the Shrine of the numbers attending, those who wish to do so are asked to add their names to the list at the back of Church.
