## Adoremus Liverpool

Following the national Adoremus Eucharistic Congress on the 14th September at St Mary's College, Oscott, the Archbishop has decided to hold a similar event for the Archdiocese at the Metropolitan Cathedral on Saturday 21st September 2024 as part of our preparation for the Great Jubilee 2025. The day will begin with Mass at 9.00am, with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 10.00am-5.00pm, with Confessions throughout the day. There will be a series of workshops from 10.15am, with a Holy Hour, Eucharistic Procession and Benediction at 2.00pm, concluding with Mass at 5.00pm. Anyone interested in attending is asked to add their name to the list at the back of Church.

#### Lectionary at Mass

A new edition of the Lectionary, the book which contains the readings which are proclaimed at Mass, will come into use in England and Wales on the First Sunday of Advent 2024. It will use the English Standard Version – Catholic Edition for the scripture readings and the Psalms and Canticles for the Responsorial Psalms. This means that the translation of the scriptures which we have become familiar with for many years will change, and new Mass books will be needed. The existing translation used, from the Jerusalem Bible is, in fact, a translation from French. The new edition is intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive. A CTS leaflet explaining the changes is available at the back of Church this weekend.
