Through our Autumn topics we will cover the 7 areas of learning; Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication and Language, Physical Development, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding of the World and Expressive Arts and Design. Topics are subject to change according to children's interests.

Literacy

In Literacy, our topics are Knowing Yourself and Outside Inside. As we explore books in detail, we will begin to write words, signs, and captions.

Religious Education

Our topics in RE are Myself, Welcome and Birthday. We will be learning about the sacrament of Baptism and the story of Jesus' birthday, Christmas.

Physical Development

Our PE day is Thursday. We will focus on travelling in a range of ways, jumping with balance and control and attacking and defending.

Communication and Language

We will listen to, share and retell a range of books related to our topics to build up our vocabulary, and use imaginative language to join in with role play. We will practise following instructions, speaking in front of our class and listening to the ideas of others.

Mathematics

We will focus on developing our knowledge and understanding of concepts involving; exploring numbers to 5, 2D shapes, positional language, size, time, mass and capacity.



Phonics

This term we will be focusing on orally blending and segmenting phonemes, and learning to write words and sentences using Phase 2 graphemes.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we will be making friends and getting used to the rules and routines of

our class. We will be learning about ourselves, and our feelings.



Expressive Arts and Design/Understanding of the World

We will learn about our senses and our bodies, and use them to explore our own environment. We will learn about Autumn, and observe changes
