The UK government has launched an online exhibition, to show five different designs for a new national memorial for Queen Elizabeth II. The memorial is planned for St James's Park in London, England, and will be made to remember and celebrate the late Queen's 70-year reign. One design will be chosen in early summer 2025 to become the final memorial.
