7. A/an ball of string was given to Theseus by Ariadne.
8. Theseus' dad was a/an king who jumped off a cliff.
9. King Minos was a/an arrogant King who owned a/an enormous Minotaur.
10. On a/an island called Crete, Theseus was learning English.
