Our Lady's & St. Oswald's Cemeteries

Deed-holders of graves in Our Lady's and St. Oswald's Parish Cemeteries are reminded that your annual £40 maintenance fees are now due. Cash or cheques made payable to Our Lady's or St. Oswald's Parish Account may be handed into the Parish House.

Grounds maintenance has now begun, so Christmas pots should be removed and nothing placed in the ground in front of headstones which obstructs the maintenance of the grounds. Anything which does will be removed.

It would seem a number of people are struggling to understand which bins to use. Green bins are provided for garden waste only i.e. plants and flowers. Plastic wrappings or bags, and artificial flowers, are to put in the black bins. This is no different to what you would do at home. It is not the responsibility of other parishioners to sort through rubbish to ensure it is in the right bin before they go out, as has happened on more than one occasion recently. If you want the grounds to look well-kept, help to keep them so by using the correct bin.
