

Year 5 Autumn Newsletter

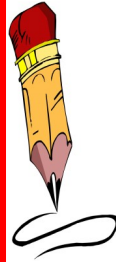


Maths

In maths we will cover the following topics: Number and place value; addition and subtraction; statistics; multiplication and division; perimeter and area.

English

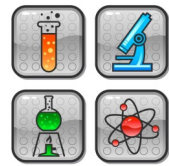

Science

In Science our topics are:

- Earth and space

Humanities

In history we will learn about *Changing Britain* and in Geography, *Biomes*.

Computing
