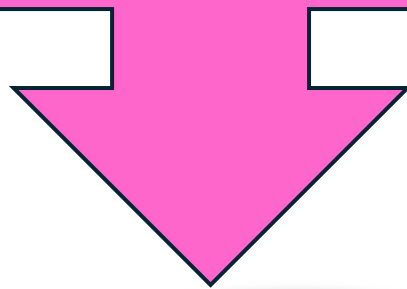
# PTFA Events
