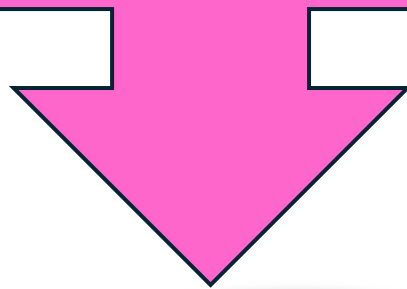
PTFA Events
