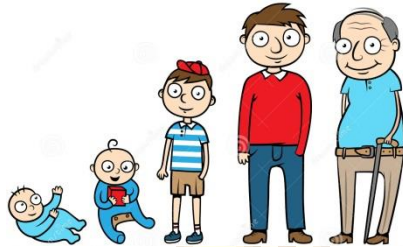
## Growth and Survival Knowledge Organiser

### Glossary

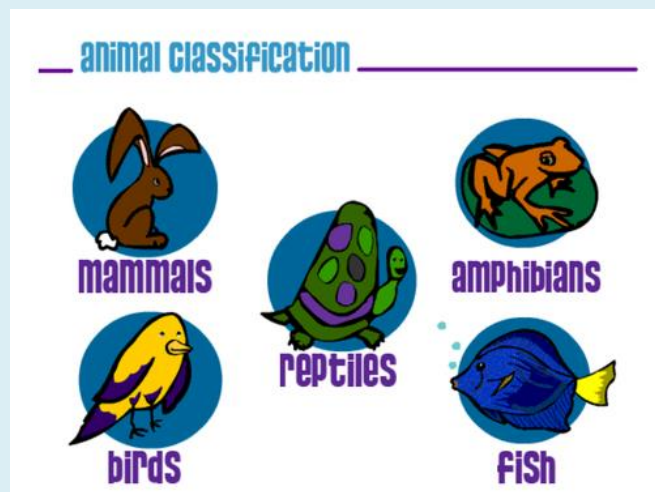
<b>growth</b>	how living things increase in size
<b>young</b>	an animal that has recently been born
<b>reproduce</b>	making offspring (babies)
<b>survival</b>	how a living thing keeps existing
<b>food</b>	Nutritious substances that maintain life
<b>oxygen</b>	a gas that humans need to survive
<b>offspring</b>	a person's children or an animal's young
<b>exercise</b>	an activity that requires physical effort
<b>environment</b>	the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal or plant lives in
<b>habitat</b>	the natural home of an animal, plant or living organism
<b>life-cycle</b>	the series of changes in the life of an animal
<b>life-processes</b>	the things that all living things do

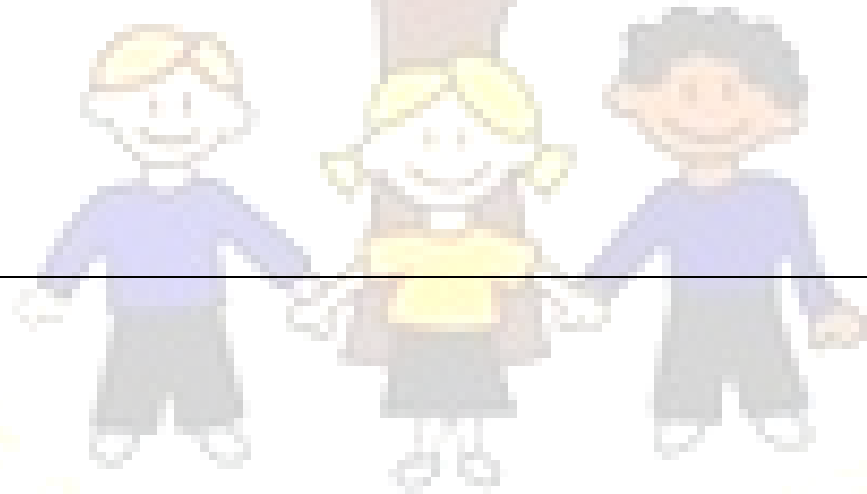

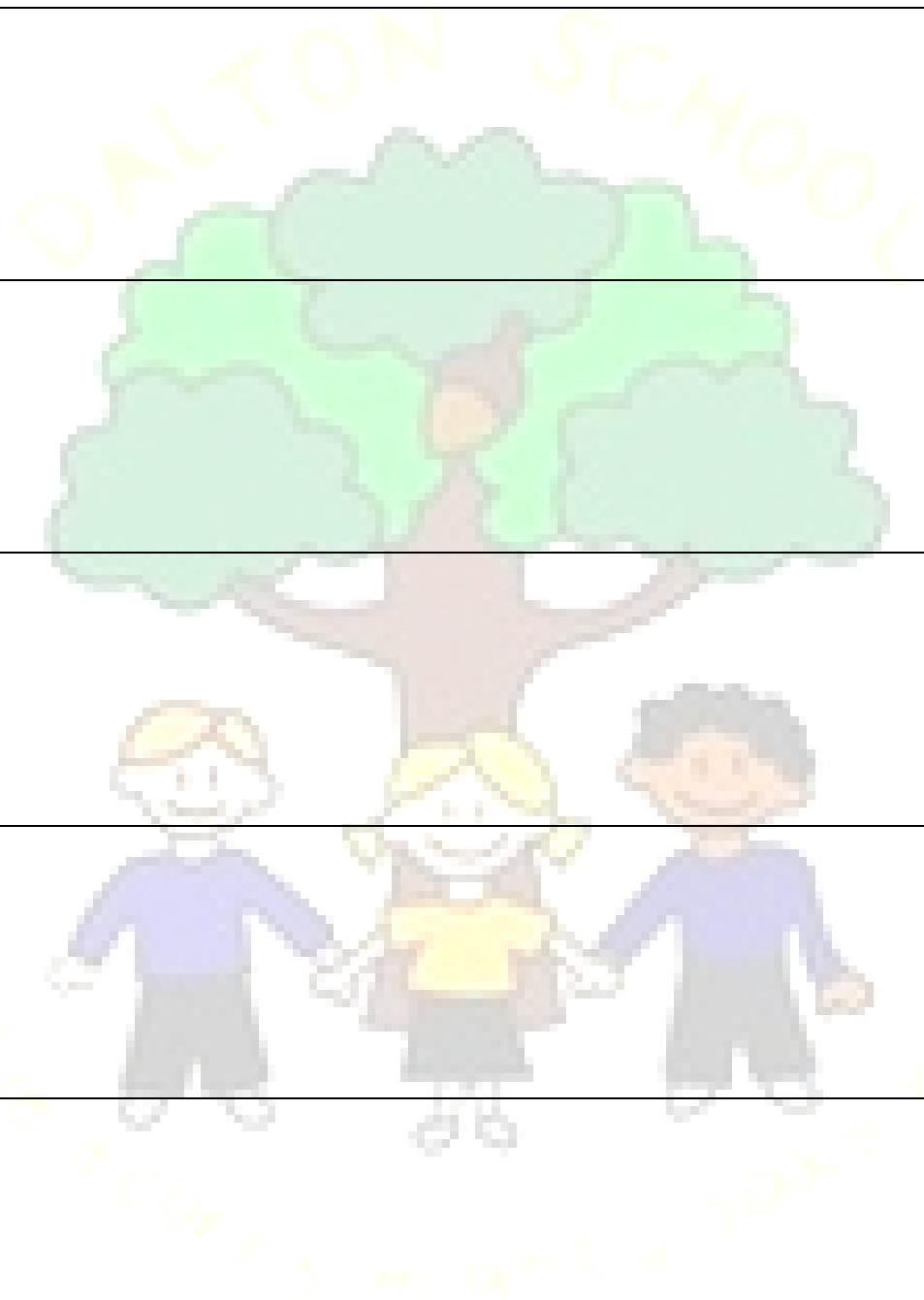
